Age Group: Eligibility in TBAWA carnivals. :

Wembley Tee Ball Association will have tryouts for Under 12

Generally **currently playing in Wembley Tee Ball U11** Competition

Therefore your child will need to be 11 or under as at 30/06/2025

Skills Test Phase One: Confident, able to throw around the bases
Able to catch from base to base
Quick movement between bases
Able to Follow Verbal Directions (prompt and correct attitude)

Skills Test Phase Two: Able to hit SAFE ground balls into spaces
Able to throw from the outfield to home plate
Sound and good knowledge of the game

Expectation of children selected:

Training will be Saturday's and Thursday's from Saturday 11 January 2025

From January 27 Trainings will be all Mondays from 5.30pm

Mandatory to Attend all training sessions (additional to normal team training)

Along with at least 3 **compulsory Pre-State Carnivals**

** Possibly 2nd and 9th and 16th February 2025 – Details to be confirmed

This seasons State Championships will be on the Labour Day Long Weekend - Saturday 1st, Sunday 2nd and Monday 3rd March 2025. All games this year to be played at Yokine Reserve.

State Championships is a commitment and an opportunity for children to play at the top level of tee ball. Teams come from all over the metropolitan area with some country towns.

Games are played back to back: 2 games Saturday, 2 Sunday and 1 game on the Monday, = 5 games.
